

# WHITMAN COUNTY PUBLIC WORKS SMALL WORKS WORKSHEET

**PROJECT NAME:** Road Stabilization Project in the Pullman, WA Area

**DESCRIPTION: (Materials, Application, Supplies, Equipment)**

Whitman County is soliciting quotes for delivery and application of Magnesium Chloride to sections of 4 roads for a total of 8 miles of treated roadway. Roads to have material applied are as follows:

- Old Moscow Rd. 1.32 miles @ 24' wide
- Sunshine Rd 1.83 miles @ 20' wide
- Kitzmiller Rd 1.7 miles @ 22wide
- Brayton Rd 3.23 miles @ 20' wide

Whitman County will provide all prep work and traffic control for the project. Successful bidder will deliver and apply two, .25 gallons per square yard applications for a total of .50 gallons per square yard applied. Bidder must use a metered distributor for an accurate and even application. Bidder will coordinate with Whitman County to ensure roadway is prepared properly prior to application. Whitman County would like to target the first or second week of May 2015 for this project to commence. Whitman County crews work 10 hour days Monday thru Thursday. Application should be for an estimated total of 99,913 square yards and 49,957 gallons applied knowing that the gallons and tons may be more or less. Material delivered must be large enough in quantity to complete at least one road per day.

This is considered a public works project so prevailing wage applies. A copy of the wages paid statement will need to be provided to Whitman County at the end of the project. Invoices will be paid within 30 days of receipt.

All delivered materials, equipment, application and supply costs (plus tax), should be included in the quote. Please provide costs per ton and a total estimated cost not including tax.
