Public Works Request for Proposals (RFP) – Yard and Wood Waste Grinding

Whitman County, Washington is seeking a qualified contractor to provide Whitman County Solid Waste a quote for the 2022 Yard and Wood Waste Grinding Contract

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The CONTRACTOR shall provide Whitman County with a quote including all labor and equipment needed to process and remove all yard and wood waste from the Whitman County Solid Waste site located approximately five miles north of Pullman, Washington and ½ mile west of State Route 195. Successful bidder shall be responsible for moving all material from existing pile to grinder without assistance from Whitman County.

Successful bidder shall have the proper equipment and personnel to move in, grind and haul up to 1,000 tons per event and be completed within five (5) business days.

All quotes shall be on a per ton basis for processing and removal of yard and wood waste.
